Online learning

- Major ideas
 - 4Cs: critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, communication, going beyond the 3Rs
 - Google Documents and other web 2.0 tools can encourage the 4Cs
 - Vicarious learning: observing somebody else's learning, eavesdropping (VoiceThread)
 - Asynchronous teaching good for shy students afraid of making mistakes
 - English not only for employment but developing an independent passion for learning,
 becoming autonomous
 - Developing a sense of audience
 - Asking questions involves expecting others to answer, what others understand

- Generating tertiary materials as a path to learner autonomy

Multiliteracies

- 1. Make use of the learners culture/background
- 2. Make use of multiple modes (visual, audio, kinesthetics, spatial)

E.g. BEd course (create website, analyse textbooks, summarize the units, audio visual presentations, peer review study) (Related: Gunther Kress <u>Gunther Kress</u> - <u>Wikipedia</u>)

- Managing with the complexity of multiliteracy activities
- Cultural awareness with multiliteracies
 - Making students aware of cultural influences on authentic language
 - Teaching students to notice cultural influences on language
 - Using Indian English authors to help Indian learners
 - Using materials written in English by authors from the host country to aid in understanding in cultural influences on language
 - Is this possible in Japan?
